All Souls will once again be hosting Totus Tuus from July 20-25. Run by a team of four college-aged missionaries, Totus Tuus is a Catholic youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through catechesis, evangelization, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship. There will be two programs tailored to specific age groups. The daytime program, specifically for children entering grades 1–6 in the fall, will take place Monday-Friday from 9:00am to 2:30pm. This session is capped at 80 participants, with a fee of \$60 per child. The evening program, for those entering grades 7–12, will be held Sunday-Thursday from 7:00–9:00pm. Attendance to the evening program is free of charge.

Open to children aged 3–5 who will be entering preschool, pre-kindergarten, or kindergarten in the fall, our camp is designed to spark young curious imaginations through a variety of activities. There are six 3-day camp sessions to choose from, each focusing on a different country with activities celebrating diverse cultures.

The cost for each 3-day session is \$227 for half-day (8:00am-1:00pm) and \$275 for full-day (8:00am-3:00 pm) enrollment. Families can register for multiple sessions, with a one-time non-refundable \$50 registration fee. Current School & ELC families can register via their FACTS account during the 2025–2026 enrollment period without extra forms.
