

REQUIESCAT IN PACE Deacon Marty Wager December 21, 1949 -May 10, 2025

Deacon Marty Wager passed into the loving embrace of our Lord on May 10 after a brief battle with pancreatic cancer.

Ordained in 1989 by His Eminence, Cardinal Stafford, Deacon Marty served faithfully at St. Louis Catholic Parish in Englewood from 1989–2004 and at All Souls from 2004 until his retirement this past December. His heart for the vulnerable was evident in his work with the Handicap Ministry through Carron House and the EnCourage Ministry for families within Courage International.

Due to the Church Renovation here at All Souls, funeral services for Deacon Marty will take place at **St. Frances Cabrini Catholic Parish, located at 6773 W. Chatfield Ave. in Littleton.**
