# On behalf of Fr. Rick, Deacon Kelvin and Deacon Kevin, All Souls is excited to welcome Jeff Nepple as our newest Deacon!

Born and raised in Iowa, Deacon Jeff grew up in a small town along the Mississippi River where he was nurtured in a strong Catholic family. Meeting his wife, Julie, while they were in high school, they have been together ever since and are proud parents to three wonderful children: Cecilia, Cody and Luke. With a degree in Mechanical Engineering from Iowa State University and an MBA from the University of Iowa, Jeff's career has taken him and his family from Iowa to Evergreen, Colorado, then to California and eventually returning to Colorado, currently residing in Littleton. He is currently managing a commercial lighting factory in Aurora.

During his time in California, Deacon Jeff began his journey in spiritual direction and started attending weekly adoration, while he and his family participated in pro-life ministries. All Souls will once again be hosting Totus Tuus the week of **July 20–25**. Totus Tuus is a Catholic youth program run by four college missionaries focused on sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith. It offers two age-specific programs:

- Daytime: For children entering grades 1–6, this program runs Monday–Friday from 9:00am–2:00pm. There's a limit of 80 participants and a \$60 registration fee per participant.
