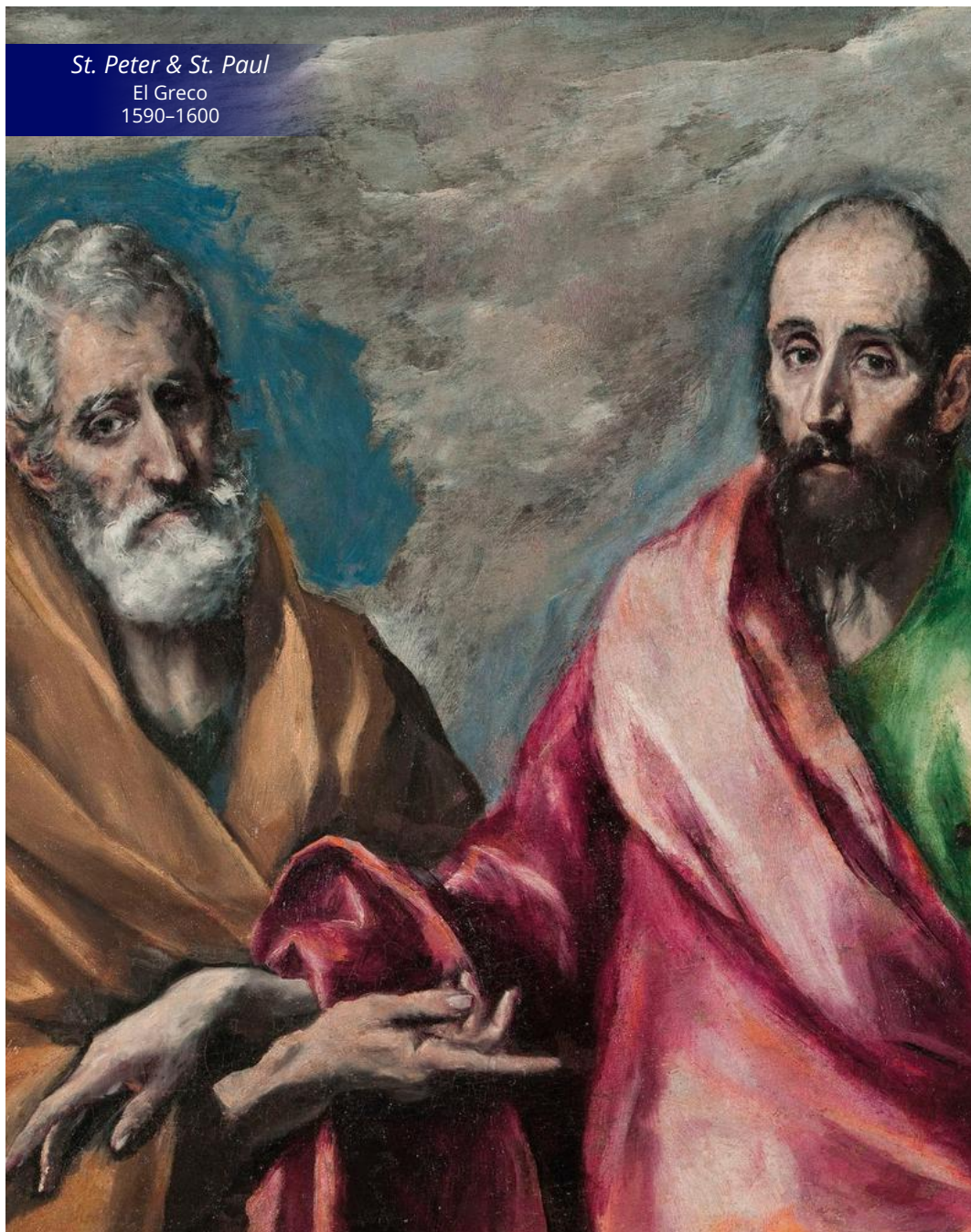

## Totus Tuus

All Souls will once again be hosting Totus Tuus the **week of July 20–25**. Totus Tuus is a Catholic youth program run by four college missionaries focused on sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith. There will be two age-specific youth programs during the week:

- **DAYTIME:** For **children entering grades 1–6**, this program runs **Monday–Friday from 9:00am–2:00pm**. There's a limit of 80 participants and a **\$60** registration fee per participant.
- **EVENING:** For **those entering grades 7–12**, this free program runs **Sunday–Thursday from 7:00–9:00pm** in the School Cafeteria.
