LOCATION CHANGE FOR WEEKDAY SERVICES!

Beginning this Wednesday, July 30, the weekday Adoration at 11:00am and the Daily Mass on weekdays at 12:00pm will be held in the School Gym through Friday, August 15. Adoration and Daily Mass will move back to Jaeger Hall on Monday, August 18, though be prepared that this may occur earlier if the new air conditioning system in Jaeger Hall is fully operable beforehand.
