In response to recent events, we are now launching two important security initiatives that will further protect our Parish, School, and ELC families—ensuring that everyone can gather and worship in safety and peace within our beautifully renewed Church.

# FIRST PRIORITY Expanded Fencing

- Extend security fencing around the Church, Jaeger Hall and Parish Office.
- Projected cost: \$33,550



Certification is valid for five years, after which you must renew your status by attending a training session to maintain compliance.
