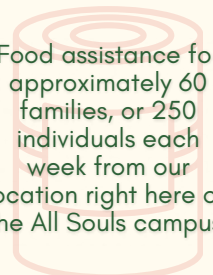
HOW IT WORKS

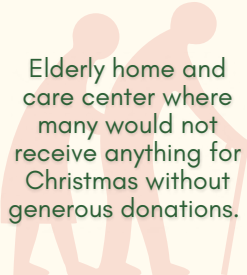

CHERRELYN HEALTHCARE



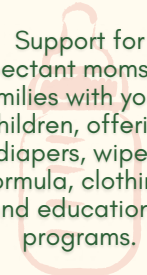
Elderly home and care center where many would not receive anything for Christmas without generous donations.

LITTLE FLOWER MATERNITY HOME



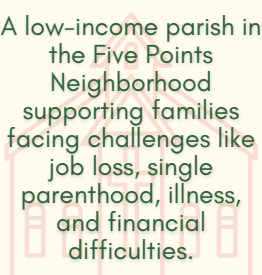
Free housing for pregnant mothers in need, operating solely on the generosity of donors.

MARISOL FAMILY



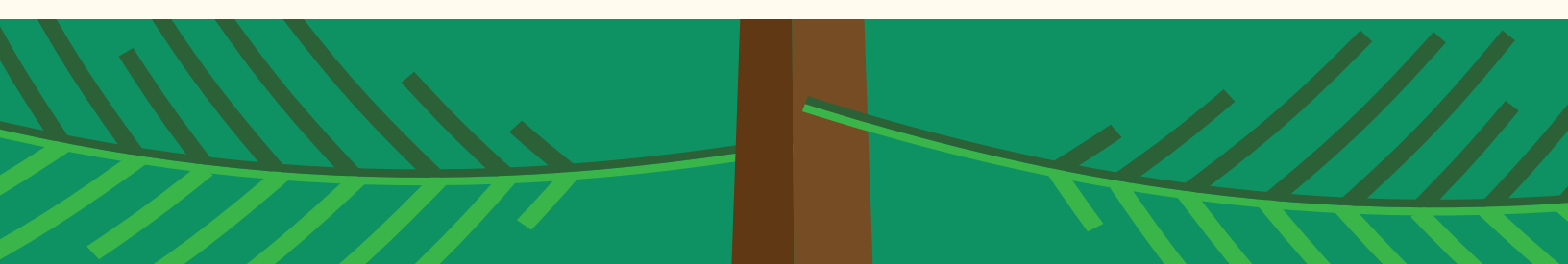
Support for expectant moms and families with young children, offering diapers, wipes, formula, clothing, and educational programs.
