Please note that opting for additional blood testing is not included in the package price. Insurance is not required, and appointment availability is limited.

When it comes to preventative health, it's essential to prioritize annual screenings, so don't miss out on this chance to get screened for early detection of potentially serious conditions. These vital screenings are typically not included in your annual check-up, and insurance may not cover them unless you show symptoms.

Totus Tuus Returns This Summer!

JULY 12-17

All Souls will once again be hosting Totus Tuus this summer during the week of **July 12-17**. Run by a team of college-aged missionaries and a seminarian, Totus Tuus is a Catholic youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through catechesis, evangelization, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship, along with games, music, skits and more! There will be two programs tailored to specific age groups. The **DAYTIME PROGRAM**, specifically for children entering grades **1-6** in the fall, will take place Monday-Friday from 9:00am-2:30pm. This session is capped at 80 participants, with a cost of **\$100** per child. The **EVENING PROGRAM**, for those entering grades **7-12**, will be held Sunday-Thursday from 7:00-9:00pm. Attendance to the evening program is free of charge.
