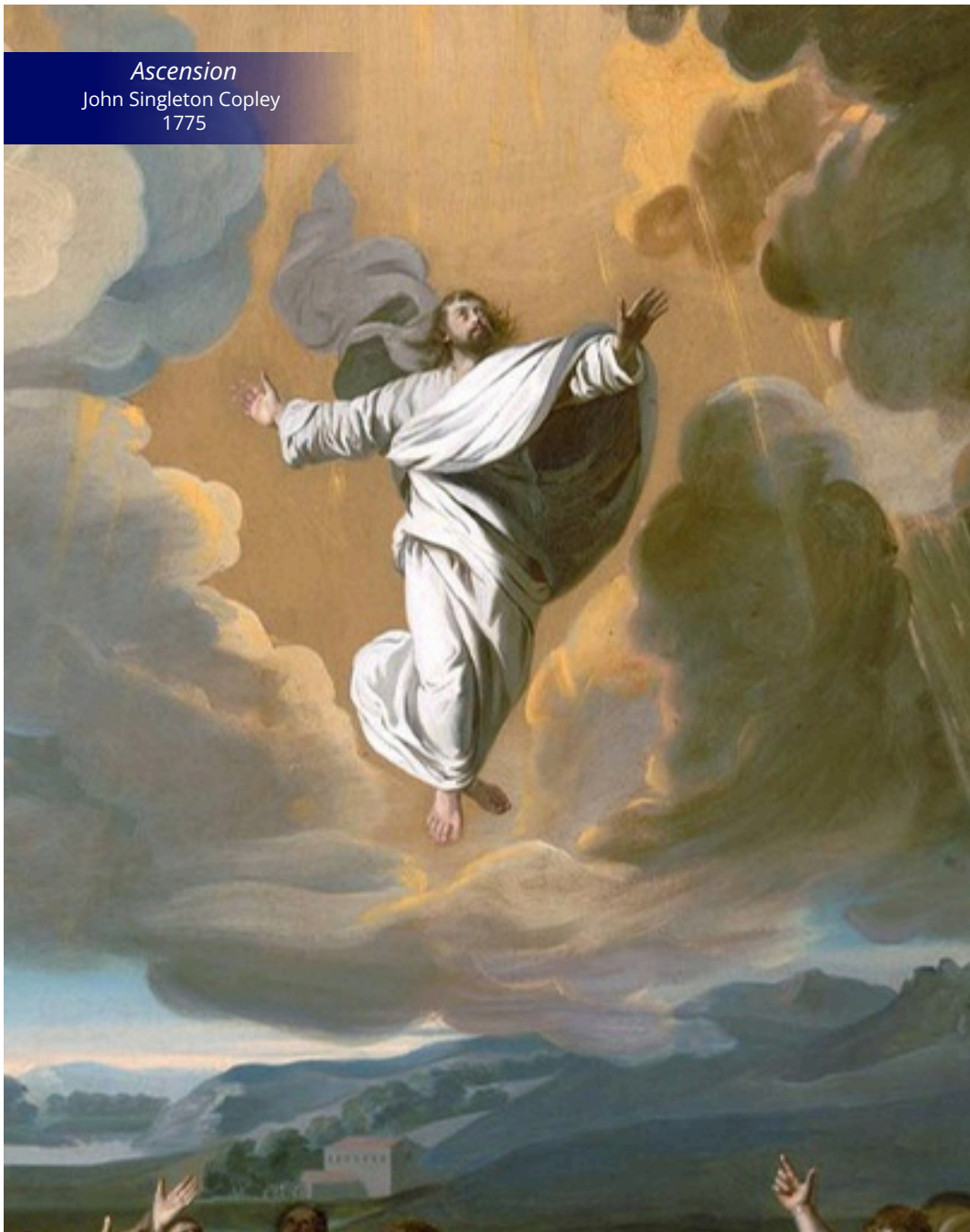

## Totus Tuus Returns This Summer!

JULY 12-17

All Souls will be hosting Totus Tuus the week of **July 12-17**. Led by college-aged missionaries and a seminarian, this Catholic youth program promotes the faith through catechesis, evangelization, and worship, along with games and activities. There will be two programs offered:

- **DAYTIME** - For children entering grades **1-6**: Monday-Friday from 9:00am-2:30pm. Attendance is capped at 80 participants with a cost of **\$100** per child.
