Educational Freedom Tax Credit

Beginning January 2027, a new federal tax credit will empower families to redirect up to \$1,700 of their tax liability to fund scholarships that will provide tuition assistance to K–12 students attending Catholic schools. Donors receive a dollar-for-dollar federal tax credit (up to \$1,700) when they donate to a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) such as ACE Scholarships or Seeds of Hope. **Donations can be directed specifically to All Souls Catholic**, making this a powerful way to strengthen our school's sustainability for FREE.
