Prayer Formation Survey

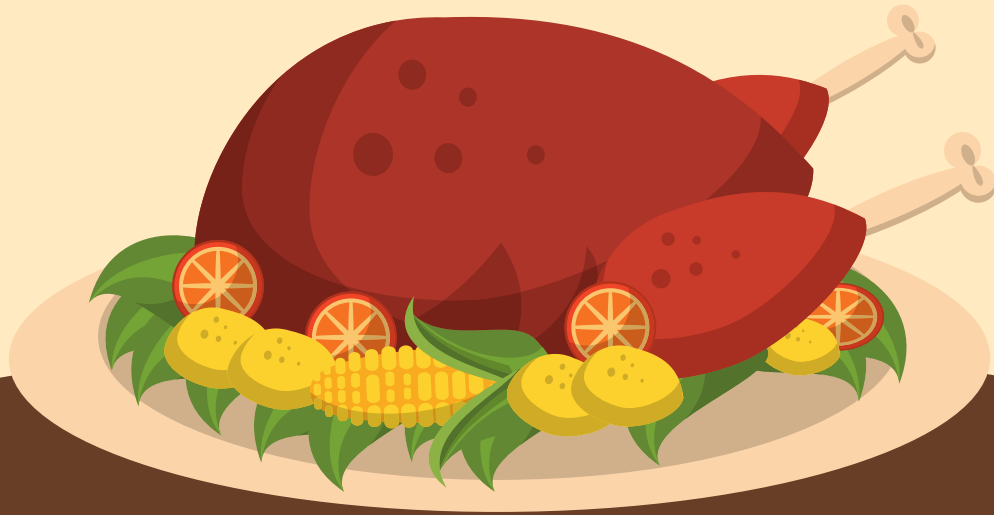
