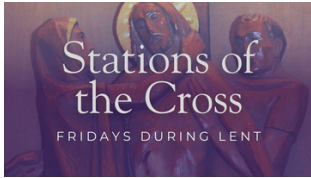
Catholic Inquiry Night TUESDAY, APRIL 8
