



# K-8 Dress Code

All Souls Catholic School has a uniform dress code for all students in grades K-8. There are two separate designated uniforms for students. The "Everyday Uniform" is worn on regular school days and the "Dress Uniform" is worn on Mass days, and other designated days.

## Everyday Uniform – required daily, except Mass days require dress uniform

### Boys K-5

Red Polo Shirt long or short sleeved  
Khaki Uniform Pants (**no cargo or jean pockets**)  
Khaki Uniform Shorts (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Belts in black, brown, or navy (**required for 3-8**)  
Socks in **solid** red, navy, or white.

### Boys 6-8

Navy Blue Polo Shirt long or short-sleeved  
Khaki Uniform Pants (**no cargo or jean pockets**)  
Khaki Uniform Shorts (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Belts in black, brown, or navy (**required for 3-8**)  
Socks in **solid** red, navy, white, khaki, or black

### Girls K-5

Red Polo Shirt long or short sleeved  
Khaki Uniform Pants (**no cargo or jean pockets**)  
Khaki Uniform Shorts (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Belts in black, brown, or navy (**required 3-8**)  
Uniform Plaid Jumper (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Uniform Plaid Skort (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Socks/Knee Highs/Tights in **solid** red, navy, or white.

### Girls 6-8

Navy Blue Polo Shirt long or short-sleeved  
Khaki Uniform Pants (**no cargo or jean pockets**)  
Khaki Uniform Shorts (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Khaki Uniform Skirt/Skort (**2 in. above knee**)  
Plaid Uniform Skirt/Skort (**2 in. above knee**)  
Belts in black, brown, or navy (**required for 3-8**)  
Socks/Knee Highs/Tights in **solid** red, navy, or white

## Dress Uniform – required for all Mass days, field trips, and special occasion days.

### Boys K-8

White Button-Down Oxford long or short-sleeved  
Red Sweater Vest with All Souls Dress Logo  
Khaki Uniform Pants (**no cargo or jean pockets**)  
Plaid Mass Tie (**required for 6-8**)  
Belts in black, brown, or navy (**required for 3-8**)  
Socks in **solid** red, navy, or white  
Closed-toed shoes, no Crocs or sandals permitted

### Girls K-8

White Button-Down Oxford long or short-sleeved  
Red Sweater Vest with All Souls Dress Logo  
Uniform Plaid Skirt/Skort/Jumper (**2 in. above knee**)  
Khaki Uniform Pants (**no cargo or jean pockets**)  
Belts in black, brown, or navy (**required for 3-8**)  
Socks/Knee Highs/Tights in **solid** red, navy, or white  
Closed-toed shoes, no Crocs or sandals permitted

## Dress Up Days – (Non-Uniform Days Only)

### Boys K-8

Dress Slacks  
Dress Shorts (non-mass days)  
Dress Shirt with collar  
Crew Socks  
Closed-toed shoes, no Crocs or sandals permitted

### Girls K-8

Dresses or Skirts (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
Dress Slacks  
Dress Shorts (Non-Mass Day) (**2 in. above knee**)  
Dress blouse or sweater top  
Closed-toed shoes, no Crocs or sandals permitted  
**No thin straps, strapless or backless tops.**

## Dress Down Days (Non-Uniform Days Only)

### Boys K-8

Blue Jeans  
Athletic Shorts or Sweats  
T-Shirts (**no offensive logos or pictures**)  
Socks

### Girls K-8

Blue Jeans or Pants or Sweats  
Shorts, Skirts, or Skorts (**2 in. above knee or longer**)  
T-Shirts (**no offensive logos or pictures**)  
Socks/Knee Highs/ Tights



# K-8 Dress Code

## General Uniform Policies

<b>Belts</b>	Belts with designs, patterns, or colors other than black, brown, and navy are not permissible
<b>Socks</b>	Socks must be visible and <b>solid</b> red, navy, or white. Socks with designs, patterns or other colors are not permissible.
<b>Shoes</b>	Athletic shoes or closed-toed shoes must be worn daily. No open-toed shoes. Crocs or sandals are not permitted. Shoes should be scuff-free
<b>Pants and Shorts</b>	Pants and shorts must have slit back pockets. No jean pockets, no flaps, no cargo pockets are allowed. Skinny pants, cargo pants and shorts, and jean pants and shorts are not permissible. <b>Shorts must be 2 inches above the knee or longer.</b>
<b>Skirts and Skorts</b>	Skirts must be either a solid khaki or the school designated plaid. <b>Skirts and skorts must be 2 inches above the knee or longer.</b>
<b>Polo Shirts</b>	Shirts must be red or navy polo style, long or short-sleeved. Shirts must be plain or with an AllSouls approved logo only. Shirts must be tucked in always.
<b>White Dress Shirts</b>	White button-down oxford shirts may be long or short-sleeved. Shirts must be plain and tucked in always.
<b>Sweaters</b>	Sweaters worn during the school day, must be plain red, white, or navy blue pullover or cardigans.
<b>Sweatshirts</b>	Sweatshirts worn during the school day, must be red, grey or navy blue with an All Souls approved logo.
<b>Turtle Necks</b>	Turtle necks worn during the school day, must be worn under the regular uniform polo shirt and must be plain red or navy to match the color of the regular uniform polo shirt.
<b>T-shirts</b>	Plain white t-shirts with no designs or pictures may be worn under regular uniform polo shirt.
<b>PE Uniform</b>	Grey t-shirt with All Souls Logo and navy blue mesh shorts or navy sweatpants purchased from Dennis or Educational Outfitters. <b>Required for grades 3-8.</b>

## Important Requirements

- **Skirts, Skorts, and Shorts must be 2 inches above the knee or longer.**
- **No thin straps, strapless or backless tops are allowed.**
- **Straps must be the width of at least 3 fingers.**
- **NO SPANDEX is allowed**
- **NO SHORT SHORTS are allowed**
- **NO PAJAMA PANTS are allowed unless it is PJ DAY.**

## Other Important Uniform Policies

- **Skirts, Dresses, Jumpers, Skorts must be at the top of the knee – 2 inches above the knee or longer**
- Shorts may be worn under skirts, dresses, or jumpers.
- Boys may not wear earrings at school or school related activities.
- Boys' hair is to be above the collar, off the ears and out of the face, this includes

sideburns.

- Girls may wear two earrings per ear, but no dangling or large loop earrings.
- Girls and boys may not have dyed, highlighted, partial or tipped hair is included in this policy.
- Girls may not wear hairpieces or extensions.
- Girls and boys are to have groomed hairstyles. No shaved heads. Designs of any kind are not allowed.
- Bangs on the girls must be above the eyes.
- Nails for girls may be polished but other forms of make-up are not permitted.
- Students are not allowed to wear hats in the building during school or school related activities.
- No animal headbands, cat ears, unicorn horn headbands, etc. will be allowed.
- Excess jewelry is not permitted; this includes chains and other "in" things or piercings.
- Tank tops, shirts that display alcohol, drugs, heavy metal, or other rock logos may not be worn to school or school related activities.
- No short shorts are allowed. All shorts worn on uniform or free dress days must be no more than **2 inches above the knee or longer**.
- Clothes with holes are not permitted.
- Clean clothes should always be worn.
- No make-up is allowed at any time during the school day. This includes mascara, colored lip glosses, and foundation.

NOTE: The purpose of the uniform is to show community, maintain balance, and reduce peer pressure. If students do not follow the dress code, it undermines our purpose; therefore, we ask that both parents and students respect our uniform policies always, **including the guidelines for socks and the length of shorts and skirts**. The principal reserves the right to determine if a student is in violation of the uniform code. Parents are expected to respect the decisions of the administration regarding the uniform codes.

### Dress Code Violation Procedures

The following procedures will be followed when a student is in violation of the dress code and all information contained in this document.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Student will be given a written warning to be taken home and signed by parent.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Parent(s) will be called and asked to bring the proper clothing or will be asked when the haircut, etc. is scheduled.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Student will have a detention and a parent conference will be scheduled. It is now escalated to a respect issue.
